### Upper Mattagami Canoeing Adventures:

*Itineraries can be customized and developed based on group size, ages, interests, timing, etc.*

#### Novice route - Lake to Lake - easy - 0/2 portages daily

##### Day 1:

Arrive at Wawaitin Holiday Park 1:00PM. Meet your guide, welcome refreshments, orientation and registration, water safety, and head out the old rail road town of Gogama.

##### Day 2:

After a hardy breakfast, put-in at the town docks and paddle North with the river's flow. Note the Mattagami first nation reserve on your way to Kenogamissi falls. Make the portage and set up camp.

##### Day 3:

A leisurely paddle through the headwaters of Kenogamissi Lake and some great angling opportunities. After a shore lunch find your way to Post 392 for a culinary treat and overnight stay.

##### Day 4:

Local native Heritage is the day's theme while paddling beautiful Kenogamissi Lake. Perhaps pick some wild blue berries and mushrooms and photograph the beaver repairing its house on the shore. Tonight's feast will be at Wawaitin Holiday Park.

##### Day 5:

After portaging Wawaitin Falls your on your way to the City with a heart of gold! There are also opportunities to view and photograph other wildlife such as the timid but majestic moose. Tonight will be first class accommodation at Cedar Meadows.

##### Day 6:

A quick portage around Sandy Falls and your once again flowing North on the Mattagami. Set up camp for the last time and enjoy the sound of silence.

##### Day 7:

This morning you will be picked up for a ride back to Wawaitin Holiday Park. A 'Thanks for Coming' lunch will be served before departing at 1:00PM. WildExodus knows you'll be back!
